CELEBRATING THE SUCCESS OF MY STUDENT LOAN RELIEF FOR NURSES PROGRAM

was proud to work with PHEAA, former Governor Wolf and Senator Vincent Hughes to develop the \$55 million Student Loan Relief for Nurses (SLRN) program. This fall, we celebrated the program's success by presenting a \$7,500 ceremonial check to one of the thousands of relief recipients. While SLRN is currently closed to new applicants, I will keep fighting for the continuation and expansion of this vital program. ■

LEGISLATIVE WINS!

No Pelvic Exams Without Consent

As a nurse, I know just how critical it is that practitioners can learn how to administer care on actual patients – but that training should never come



g should never come at the expense of a patient's right to bodily autonomy. In November, Governor Shapiro signed **HB 507**, the companion bill to my and Senator Muth's **SB 549** into law as **Act 31 of 2023**. This law prohibits the archaic

practice of nonconsensual pelvic, prostate or rectal exams on anesthetized patients for training purposes.

Preserving Access to Medication Assistance

■ SB 607, my legislation with Senator J. Ward, ensures that older Pennsylvanians do not lose access to the PACE/PACENET prescription assistance programs due to an increase in their Social Security payments. The Governor signed the bill into law as Act 62 in December!

Protecting Victims of Human Trafficking

Also in December, the legislature sent SB 44 to the Governor's desk where it became Act 39 of 2023. Part of a legislative package I introduced with Senators Dush and Phillips-Hill, this reform will ensure that victims of human trafficking no longer have to identify a perpetrator in order to access critical victim services.

Addressing Long Term Care Staffing Issues

Under SB 668, which passed unanimously through the Senate in November, the Certified Nursing Assistants who work closely with long term care residents can receive the training they need to safely administer medications, helping us address healthcare staffing gaps and boost career opportunities. I'm looking forward to the House considering this bill in the spring!

Improving Access to Dental Screenings in PA Schools

The Governor also signed into law Act 55, which was the House version of a bill I introduced with Sen. Brown that will allow Dental Hygienists to conduct school dental screenings. Oral health is vital to our overall health – especially for kids – and this change will make a huge difference for schools that aren't able to secure a partnership with a dentist to meet existing state requirements.



PATIENT SAFETY ACT

We know that short staffing leads to burnout for nurses and can lead to adverse health outcomes for patients. That's why I've introduced the **Patient Safety Act**, which would set safe nurse-to-patient ratios, each session. The House passed the **Patient Safety Act** in June, and now it is time for the Senate to act.



ROOM FOR PROGRESS

Improving Sexual Harassment Policies in State Government

There can be no tolerance for sexual harassment in any workplace – especially one that serves the people of our Commonwealth. Our government agencies and public servants should be held to the highest standards, and when misconduct occurs, there must be a clear path to accountability and justice. I introduced bipartisan legislation to do just that by helping to strengthen workplace protections and improve transparency. 2023 was an eventful year serving the 12th District! I'm so proud of what my team and I were able to accomplish for our constituents, and we're looking forward to continuing that work in 2024.
